A brief history of the Priory Church



Christians have worshipped on this site for more than 1,400 years. It was over 900 years ago in 1094 that Ranulf Flambard, a friend of William Rufus, and later the Bishop of Durham, began to build the great Church we see today.

By 1150 when Pope Eugenius established the Order of Augustinian Canons here at the request of Henry of Blois, Bishop of Winchester and Baldwin de Redvers, the Church was substantially complete with a central tower and spire. The Church's fame was already so widespread, with its Miraculous Beam, its growing library of illuminated manuscripts and many works of healing, that the old Royal Burgh of Twynham was becoming known as 'Christchurch'.

By 1210 the first of many misericords had been carved for the monk's stalls and 150 years later the Jesse screen in the Great Quire was in place, with the Lady Chapel being built 30 years later. After the central tower fell in about 1420, a Western tower was

added to hold the bells, which were already 50 years old. The Quire was rebuilt in the early 16th century.

Like most monasteries, the Priory Church suffered at the hands of Henry V111 and the conventual buildings were destroyed. Though the last Prior, John Draper had to surrender its treasures, the Church was saved and granted to the townsfolk. It has continued to serve the community ever since.

Over the centuries this Parish Church has given sanctuary to citizens during the civil war between Stephen and Matilda, sheltered Cromwell's soldiers, provided a school from about 1140, first in its cloisters and later in St. Michael's Loft and cared for the sick and poor. Primarily, however, it has been a place of worship and inspiration in peace and war to those from around the world.

Today the Friends and others still work to maintain it as a fitting House of God where all are welcome.
